

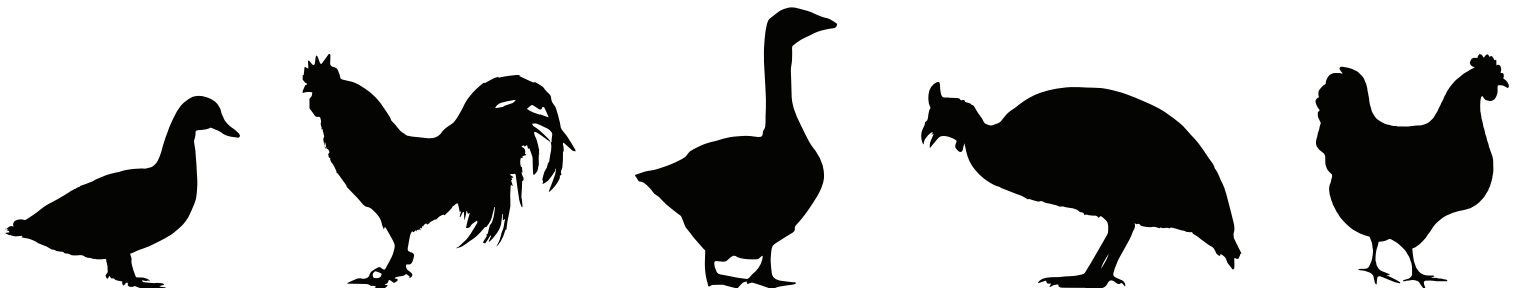
# Poultry Resources for Ohio 4-H
