4-H HORSE COMPLEX BARN RULES

- 1. Absolutely NO: double riding, bareback riding or riding with tennis shoes or shorts. No one but the exhibitor is to ride their equine project.
- 2. Wearing headgear is strongly encouraged.
- 3. Stall I.D./Emergency Cards must be completely filled out and posted on the stall not covering the stall number. This card must not be removed.
- 4. Horses and ponies are not permitted outside the Horse Complex area, and are not to be inside the split-rail fence on either side of the entry booth.
- 5. Un-Sportsmanlike conduct, foul language, horseplay, etc., will not be tolerated.
- 6. Riding of horses in the barn aisle ways is not allowed.
- 7. NO SMOKING
- 8. All trailers must be parked in their designated area directly after unloading horse and tack.
- 9. Horse trailers or campers (individual or combined) are not allowed to use electric from any horse barn.
- 10. Sitting on top rails of stalls is not allowed.
- 11. Each horse/pony assigned to a stall must remain in the same stall until dismissed on the final day of the fair.
- 12. Trash barrels/boxes are to be moved to pick up area each night for disposal.
- 13. Clean up the wash area after bathing your horse/pony. Wash rack manure goes into the pit.
- 14. Exhibitors are to clean their own stalls.
- 15. Double check your equine project before leaving at night or going to dorm.
- 16. Hay, grain and bedding must be stored in your trailer and NOT kept in or near the barns.
- 17. Haul-ins may sign up for extra stalls at the entry booth. Drawing will be done at 9:00 am each day. You are responsible to clean your stall before you leave for the day.
