During the 2018 Licking County 4-H Camp, participants will experience a number of fun activities carefully selected by their counselors and adult staff. This year's camp will have a theme that takes everyone on an Hawaiian Island Adventure! We'll sit under palm trees and enjoy time in the pool – but don't forget all the great camp activities, too! There will be games and color group challenges, as well as teambuilding activities, super sessions, nature exploration, water games, and a 4-H Camp's Got Talent showcase! 4-H Camp will present you with a great opportunity to have fun, make new friends, and create memories to last a lifetime! You won't want to miss the 2018 Licking County 4-H Camp!!!

Camp fee includes all meals and snacks, insurance, general activity materials, pool pass, all lodging expenses, materials for many sessions—and a commemorative 4-H camp shirt! All counselors will have received a minimum of 24 hours of training in 2018 in order to facilitate this camping experience. Some counselors have as many as five years of experience that they bring with them to camp with them — and don't forget our adult staff who have a lifetime of camp experience!

Parents are strongly encouraged to thoroughly discuss session preferences with their child. All classes have size limits, thus assignments will be made on a first-come, first-served basis (in the order that registration forms are received). Please be aware that some sessions require additional fees, have age requirements, or ask that the camper bring specific materials with them to camp. Once we receive your preferences, and assign classes, we will then contact you just prior to camp with any special fees or supplies that you should bring with you to camp.

<u>Cabin & Color Group Assignments</u> will be made prior to camp. All campers are invited to list up to three campers with whom they would like be in a cabin (same gender / within one year of age) or color group (either gender / any age). They will be paired up with at least one of their preferences in each case, if possible. The age of the youth is taken into consideration when cabins are assigned.

<u>Specifically for youth ages 12+</u>: High Ropes Training is available to youth ages 12-18 for an additional fee. A special Night Zip Line experience will also be offered at no cost on the first night of camp! There will also be String Art and Canvas Painting classes for those age 12 and older... And be careful to check age requirements on Shooting Sports sessions.

Archery: Learn archery basics with a certified shooting sports instructor. (201 / 301 / 501 / 601 / 801 / 901)

Balloon Animals: Have fun learning the basics of making balloon animals. The options are endless! Cost: \$3.00 (101 / 401 / 701)

**Basketball: Hit the court to enjoy some hoops with other campers. (302 / 602 / 902)

Camp Songs: Like to sing camp songs? This is an opportunity to learn new songs, and assist counselors in leading songs during camp activities. (202)

Canoeing & Kayaking: This easy session will teach you the basics of canoeing and kayaking at 4-H Camp Ohio. (203 / 303 / 502 / 603 / 802 / 903)

**Canvas Painting: Sure to be a new favorite, try out your painting skills! Be as creative as you like! Cost: \$3.00 (702 / 803)

Cards & Table Games: Try something new or play some old favorites! Challenge your friends and see how good you really are! (304 / 604 / 904)

** Chess for Beginners / Chess: Advanced Play: Learn how to play, or step up your game in the advanced session to learn how to win – you're choice! Chess for Beginners - SINGLE SESSION (503) / Chess: Advanced Play - DOUBLE SESSION (504)

Crafts, Crafts, Crafts: This is a chance to do all your favorites: shrink dinks, friendship bracelets, duct tape crafts, etc. Cost \$2.00 (102 / 402 / 703)

<u>Creeking / Stream Study</u>: Wade in to the creek at 4-H Camp Ohio and discover what's hiding under the rocks and swimming around your feet. (103 / 204 / 305 / 403 / 505 / 605 / 704 / 804 / 905)

<u>Crime Scene Investigation - Processing Fingerprints:</u> Take advantage of our resident forensics specialist while you learn about the science of fingerprints and how they are processed for identification. (506 / 606)

- Disc Golf: Enjoy learning how to play Disc Golf, and have a chance to play against other campers! (205 / 507 / 805)
- **DIY Flip Flops: You provide the flip flops, we'll provide the fabric and decorations to create a new summer favorite craft! COST: \$2.00 (607 / 906)
- Fabulous Face Painting: This is your chance to have your face painted whether it's a little rainbow on the cheek, or a full-face design... (104 / 705)
- <u>Fishing:</u> Take time out to visit the 4-H Camp Ohio pond and spend a little time with your fishing pole! Campers are welcome to bring their own pole, but it is not required; bait will be provided. DOUBLE SESSION (404)
- High Ropes: For those who would like to walk among the tree tops and try out their courage. Please note that all class activities take place among the tree tops and involve maneuvering at heights greater than 20 feet. (AGE: 12 and older). Cost: \$10.00 TRIPLE SESSION. (105 / 405 / 706)
- I Want to be A Counselor: If you're a camper (ages 11+) who has considered serving as a 4-H Camp Counselor, this is the session for you! You'll have a chance to learn more about what is involved in being a summer camp counselor. (106 / 406)
- <u>Introduction to Languages of the World:</u> Curious about different languages? This session will give you the opportunity to learn basic words and terms from Finish, Latin, and Spanish. (407)
- <u>It's A Blast Rocketry:</u> Campers will build and launch their own paper rockets while learning principles of rocketry such as trajectory, motion, speed, and aerodynamics. (306 / 907)
- <u>Line Dancing</u>: Learn all the great steps that will keep you out on the floor during the dance. A review of old favorites, and new dances, to challenge your abilities. (307 / 608 / 908)
- No-Sew Fleece Blankets: Participants will bring with them to camp the fleece fabric of their choosing... Staff members will then assist them in making measurements, cutting the fleece, and finishing it off with knots! The results: a perfect blanket for their camp bunk! DOUBLE SESSION (107 / 707)
- Outdoor Recreation Adventures: Take your pick of outdoor fun: Giant Connect Four, Gau-Gau pit, Volleyball, and 9-Square in the Air (108 / 308 / 408 / 609 / 708 / 909)

- **Paper Circuits: Learn about circuits and the flow of electricity by ising copper tape and LED lights to make cards and other faun artwork that light up! COST: 3.00 (206 / 309)

- Shooting Sports: Come and learn the basics of using a Shotgun-12+ (110) / Pistol-Age 11+ (410) / Rifle-Age 8+ (710). Equipment, goggles and ear protection provided. \$5.00 TRIPLE SESSION.
