

Licking County 4-H Cloverbud Day Camp | June 18, 2022 | 4-H Camp Ohio

Hello!

I hope your children are ready for a day of fun at 4-H Cloverbud Daycamp! The counselors and adult staff are excited to share Camp Ohio with your children. This letter will outline the details for camp.

Forms

You will find as part of this packet a copy of the Ohio 4-H Camp COVID-19 Acknowledgement. You will be asked to sign a copy of this form when you arrive at camp. If someone other than a parent/guardian is bringing your child to camp, please print and complete this form and send it with your child. Also attached is a "Restricted Release" form. If someone other than a parent/guardian will be picking up the child OR if there is a restriction on who can pick up the child (custody concern, restraining order, etc.), please complete this form as well and turn it in a registration.

Please notice that all campers have been assigned a time window during which they can arrive to camp. Please do not enter the gates of camp early (or late), as we have made this assignment to allow for best possible traffic control and ease of movement for families as they work through the check-in process. Please don't assume that you can arrive early and just park and wait until it is your turn – it won't work that way... Once you enter through the gates of camp, you are automatically in the line to complete the health screening process – which will be completed while the camper is still inside the vehicle. The departure schedule is also listed above. Please come during your scheduled time and park across from the Rec Hall. ONE adult may leave the vehicle to sign out the camper(s) that will be leaving with them. After signing out your camper(s) please immediately return to your vehicle and exit camp to allow room for the next group of parents to arrive.

IF YOU WILL ALSO BE BRINGING A SUMMER CAMPER:

Summer Camp Drop Off will take place from 9:30-11:30am. If you are bringing both a Summer Camper and a Cloverbud Day Camper, please bring both at the time your Cloverbud Day Camper is scheduled to arrive. We will not be ready to monitor Cloverbud Day Campers prior to 10:00am and ask that all Cloverbud Day Campers be checked in by 11:00am so that we can get a start to our programming while Summer Camp Drop Off finishes up. This is the first time that we have had both camps being dropped off at the same time so please be patient with us as this will certainly add a new challenge to drop-off.

General COVID-19 Guidelines

Individuals and/or family members may not attend if they or anyone living in their household is experiencing any of the following symptoms: fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of sense of taste or smell, or has been directly exposed (confirmed or suspected) to COVID-19, if they are not fully vaccinated. Please notify me immediately if a child becomes ill and is unable to attend camp, as we're more than willing to do a partial refund of your registration fees.

During camp, a child will be sent home immediately if they experience a temperature of 100.4, lose sense of taste or smell, experience shortness of breath, difficulty breathing or new cough without pre-existing condition, or experience unexplained chills.

Please notify me immediately if a child becomes ill and is unable to attend camp, as we're more than willing to partially refund your registration fees and contact individuals currently on the waitlist so that they might attend in place of your child.

Health Screening

Health Screening will take place in front of Campbell Lodge (first structure on the right upon entering camp) while the camper is still inside their vehicle. Parents will need to complete a health screening form (*sample copy included in this packet*) and sign the COVID Acknowledgement Waiver (*sample copy included in this packet*). If it is not the parent who is dropping the camper off on Saturday, June 18th, we ask that the parent print off and complete the two previously mentioned documents and send them with the camper.

During the Health Screening, temperatures will be taken for each and every camper. If any camper has a temperature of 100.3 or higher, they will have their temperature taken at least two additional times to confirm the initial reading, and then will be sent home if it remains. Please understand, if there are multiple campers in the car, and one child has a temperature of 100.3 or higher, all campers in that vehicle will be sent home. We are happy to be conducting check-in during the morning hours, when environmental temperatures are lower, but also encourage you to consider activity level of the camper prior to arriving, and the temperature inside the vehicle during your trip.

Schedule/What-to-bring

We have a busy day planned that includes:

-camp tour	-snack	-crafts	-outdoor games
-swimming	-creeking/stream study	-singing camp songs	-fun!

Upon arrival, your child will receive a camp t-shirt to wear. They need to bring/wear:

- o swim suit and beach towel
- o shoes to wear that **ARE NOT** flip flops (shoes must be closed-toe and comfortable to wear as we will be doing lots of walking and activities throughout the day, such as tennis shoes)
- o old tennis shoes, crocs or water shoes for creeking (not flip flops)
- o a plastic grocery bag (LABELED WITH THEIR NAME) for their wet clothes & towel
- o sunscreen (we will take a few breaks during the day to come back to our bags and reapply sunscreen)
- o If rain is in the forecast, please send your child with raincoat or jacket.
- o Children should not bring cell phones or other electronic devices.

Swim Time

Children will stay in the shallow end of the pool (4' deep) for a 30-minute swim. They are permitted to wear "water wings" or personal flotation device. This does not include pool noodles or other water toys that must be held.

Creeking/Stream Study

All campers will have the chance to explore the creek. Please send appropriate shoes for creeking (rubber boots, old tennis shoes, crocs, or other water shoes).


Snack/Lunch

Ohio 4-H Camp COVID-19 Acknowledgement

I will not send my child to camp if they, or any member in their household, have tested positive for COVID-19 or in the past 14 days have experienced any of the following COVID-19 symptoms:

- Congestion or runny nose
- Cough
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Fever or chills
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches
- Nausea or vomiting
- New loss of smell or taste
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

I understand that camp participation is voluntary. I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 (and its variants) and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to, or infected by, COVID-19 (or its variants) by attending the 4-H Camp, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability and/or death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to, or infected by, COVID-19 (or its variants) may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of my child(ren), myself and others, including, but not limited to, The Ohio State University, OSU Extension, 4-H camp site, and the employees, agents, representatives, volunteers and program participants and their families.

I further understand that dangers may be increased if I or my child(ren) have previously had COVID-19. Because COVID-19 is a developing disease, I understand that all of the current and future risks associated with COVID-19 are not known at this time and it is not possible to fully list every risk associated with contracting the virus. However, I am aware that COVID-19 complications while engaging in physical activity without appropriate medical clearance may lead to further injury or illness, including, but not limited to: dizziness; respiratory issues and lung damage; cardiac issues, including myocarditis (heart muscle inflammation); blood clots; general inflammation; and muscle inflammation/breakdown. I am choosing to send them to camp despite the potential risks.

As recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics, I understand my pediatrician can advise me on whether it is safe for my child to attend camp based on his or her medical history.

I understand my child must follow all COVID-19 guidance (e.g., wearing masks, distancing, etc.). Failure to do so may result in my child being sent home from camp.

I also understand I will be required to immediately pick up my child if they experience any symptoms listed above while at camp or are exposed to COVID-19. I understand I will receive a full refund of any fees paid before the start of camp. Refunds will be prorated for the days not attended if participants need to depart due to COVID-19 symptoms.
