Participants do not have to be supported by the Licking County Board of Developmental Disabilities but must reside within the Hartford Fair District – Licking County, Knox County (Hilliar / Milford / Miller Townships), or Delaware County (Berkshire / Harlem / Porter / Trenton Townships).
