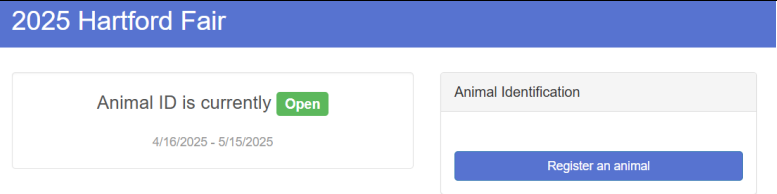


Hartford Fair Breeding Beef ID Process for Exhibitors

Breeding Beef IDs must be submitted within FairEntry (hartfordfair.fairentry.com) between April 18 and May 15, 2025.

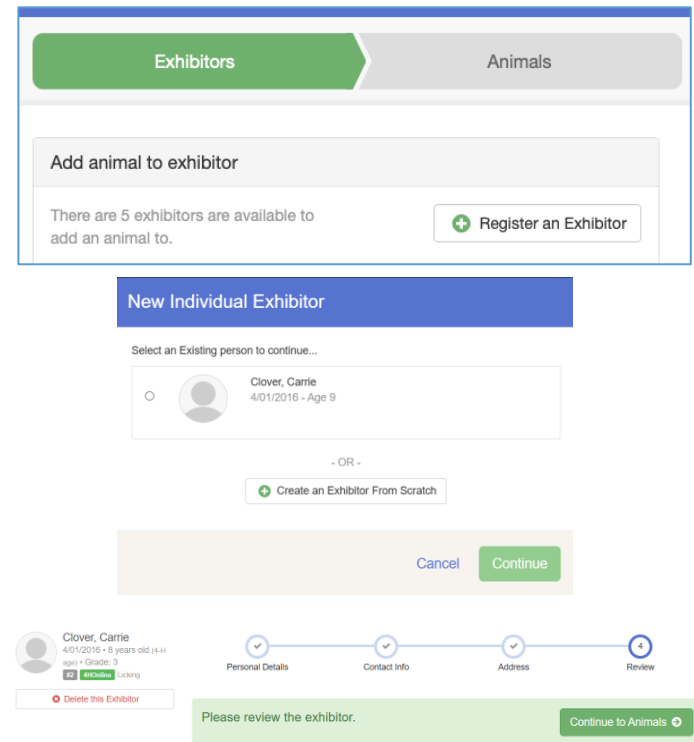
1. After logging in, the exhibitor will click on the Register an animal button. There is no option to make fair entries yet.



2. The first step is to register the exhibitor. If the exhibitor is a 4-H member, you will select their name from the imported list when you click the “Register an Exhibitor” button. If the exhibitor is an FFA member (NOT also a 4-H member), there are 3 screens to complete:

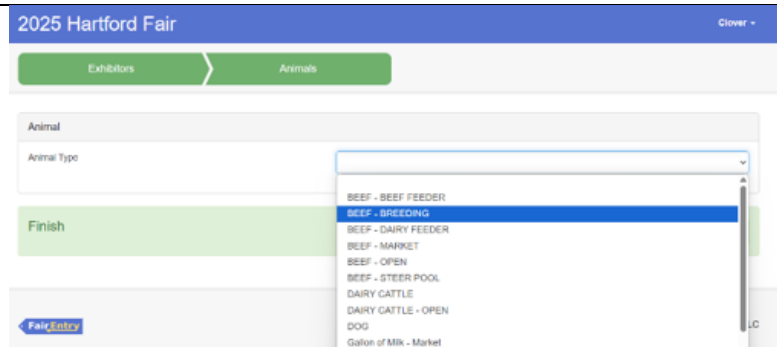
- First Name, Last Name, Birthdate, Grade – Names are required, Birthdate and Grade are controlled by your entry settings.
- Contact Info – Phone is required, email, cell phones are optional.
- Address (required)

3. When those 3 screens are complete, there is a Continue to Animals button on the Review screen.



4. The first step is to select the Animal Type to be identified.

PLEASE NOTE: Only Market Hogs and Breeding Beef should be entered at this time. You will enter other animal IDs during the entry process.



5. After all fields are complete, the exhibitor will see a Continue to Upload Files option to upload the photos of your cattle. Files uploaded must be an image file (GIF, JPG, PNG, TIFF). You will need to have your 840 RFID Tag Numbers when completing the IDs. RFID Numbers should be entered in the format: 840 XXX XXX XXX XXX

- Breeding Beef IDs must include TWO photos:
 - Side View
 - Front View

6. After clicking Finish, the exhibitor is taken to a list of all exhibitors/animals for this family. There is an option beside each to Add an Animal for that exhibitor. There is also an option to Edit existing animals. To add a new exhibitor to the family, click on the green Exhibitors tab at the top of the screen.
