### New Department Rules:

No Hanging of any air-chairs, hammocks or swings of any kind in the aisles or from the barn. Tack boxes and equipment should NOT block any aisles in barns.

No Crock pots, fridges or cooking devices to be plugged in tack stalls or aisles.

All Exhibitors, advisors, parents, and club members must abide by posted barn rules. Unsportsmanlike conduct or abuse toward an animal or others is grounds for dismissal from the fairgrounds.

No trucks and trailers removing stalled horses permitted in the haul-in area prior to (this includes trucks or trailers left in haul-in parking area on Friday night) official release time of 3:00pm EST on Saturday.

#### Champion Equine Showmanship Rules:

Eligibility:

1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners of western classes 16-22 or English classes 41-47. Eligible class winners have the option to compete in their respective Champion Showmanship division class to determine the Champion English or Champion Western Showmanship winner.

The Champion Western Showmanship winner if they place 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in their English Showmanship is INELIGIBLE to compete in the Champion English Showmanship Class.

The Western and English Champion Showmanship winners will work off after the English Championship class on Thursday to determine the Equine Showmanship Champion. The Champion Equine Showman will compete in the Super Showmanship Contest on Friday.
