



## 2020 Licking County 4-H Horse Project Qualification for State Fair Ohio State Fair PAS Instructions For Qualifying Out-Of-County

- WHO:** Licking County 4-H Horse Project members, with a valid horse ID on file, who wishes to qualify to compete in the 2020 Ohio State Fair.
- WHAT:** Youth are permitted to attempt to qualify for the Ohio State Fair in up to two single-judged qualifying shows or one double-judged shows. In order for Licking County youth to attempt to qualify in a show outside of their own county, their 4-H Educator, Lisa McCutcheon must grant approval and they must obtain permission from the 4-H Educator in the county in which they intend to qualify.
- WHEN:** All qualifications must take place by no later than Sunday, July 5<sup>th</sup> - as OSF entries are due by no later than July 6<sup>th</sup>. Licking County's OSF horse entries will be submitted by Cris Martin (614.805.2460 / [golfmom2010@gmail.com](mailto:golfmom2010@gmail.com)). Cris must receive proof of qualification by no later than 11:59 p.m. on July 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Please note that Dressage entries must be received by the OSF office by no later than July 1<sup>st</sup>. Some shows do not offer opportunities for Dressage – Licking County's 4-H Show will not offer Dressage classes. Licking County Dressage youth are encouraged to participate in qualifying / schooling shows at Southwind Stables (Amy Rothe-Hietter / 614.218.9217) ([www.southwindstables.com](http://www.southwindstables.com)), but may choose to attend other qualifying shows as needed.
- HOW:** Youth interested in attending an out-of-county OSF qualifying show must first contact Lisa McCutcheon in the Licking County Extension Office. They should explain to her why they need to attend an out-of-county qualifying show, and which show they have chosen to attend. They will then be responsible for completing the Out-Of-County PAS form and obtaining McCutcheon's signature on their form during OSUE business hours.
- The member can then make contact with the county in which they would like to participate in a qualifying show. They should verify what materials are required to be submitted and what fees will be assessed. The member is also responsible for meeting any pre-registration deadlines established by the county / show that they have chosen to attend.
- After having attended the out-of-county qualifying show, the member is responsible for providing the Out-Of-County PAS form, complete with qualifying score and show manager's signature to Cris Martin immediately. This process must be completed no later than July 5<sup>th</sup>, as entries are due to the Ohio State Fair by July 6<sup>th</sup>. It is the member's responsibility to complete online entries for the Ohio State Fair by the stated deadline (7/6 @ 1:00 p.m.).

- Out-Of-County PAS Form (Complete with signature of their 4-H Educator)
- Copy of Horse ID Form
- OSF Class listing – with classes listed / circled in which they intend to qualify
- Out of County Entry Fee: \$10 per class, maximum of four classes
  - Additional fees include: \$5 Grounds Fee / \$12 Stall Fee (optional)
