IMPORTANT ELIGIBILITY NOTES:

- Class 2, 8, 14, 20 only open to first and second year Beginners.
- Classes 75 and 76 are ONLY open to exhibitors in their first or second year of jumping (at any shows).
- If you show in class 77 & 78 you are not eligible for classes 75, 76, 79, 80.
- If you show in class 79 & 80 you are not eligible for classes 75, 76, 77, 78.
- You are only eligible to show in one English dressage class.

IMPORTANT RANCH PLEASURE NOTES:

If you choose to ride in class 52, 53, 54, 56 the same horse and rider combination CANNOT ride in class 57, 58, 59, or 60.

<u>STALL and CAMPING FEES:</u> Stall and camping fees (if not prepaid on this show tab) will be collected at the time your stall is unlocked. We realize that some exhibitors would prefer to be stalled together (by club). It will be the responsibility of the advisor or designated parent to collect appropriate fees and pay Stall Keeper upon arrival. <u>Stalls will only be unlocked after fees are paid in full.</u> Once a stall is unlocked, no refunds will be made. Any stalls that are only used for one day will be checked and relocked at the end of the show. Stall fees are \$12 per day. **Please remember to strip your stall before you leave.** The camping fee is \$25 per night. **STALLS AND CAMPING LOTS WILL NOT BE MADE AVAILABLE UNTIL 4:00 P. M. FRIDAY NIGHT.**

Veterinarian/Physician and Medication Notification Statement: The Current Uniform Rules for 4-H Shows, General Rules (pages 8-9, #2-#7) will prevail. A Veterinarian's Certificate prescribing the drug must be on file with show management <u>prior</u> to showing. No refund will be paid without written and signed veterinarian (for horse) or physician (for exhibitor) excuse. In the event that your project horse is injured, a substitution can be made with another horse (for which you have submitted an ID form by May 1st) when a veterinary certificate is presented. The substituted horse must be exhibited in the same classes as originally entered (if past entry deadlines).

No late forms will be accepted in 2020. ALL entries are due July 1, 2020.

The Licking County 4-H Program, Licking County 4-H Horse and Pony Council and Hartford Fair are not responsible for injury, theft or accidents.

*If member is unable to obtain advisor's actual signature, advisor's approval will be obtained through their submission of Category Confirmation Form by May 1st. (It is fully expected that member will review class selection with club advisor prior to submitting entry.) Parent's signature is required.
