



# 2024 Licking County 4-H Poultry Royalty

**Sponsored By:** Licking County 4-H Rabbit & Poultry Committee

**When & Where:** Sunday, April 28, 2024 – 2:30 p.m. – OSU Extension Licking County Office

**Who can compete:** Any boy or girl 9-12 (as of January 1, 2024) for Junior King or Queen and any boy or girl 13-18 (as of January 1, 2024) for Senior King or Queen. One contestant from the 9-12 age group will be chosen to serve as Junior King or Queen and one contestant from the 13-18 age group will be chosen to serve as Senior King or Queen.

**Requirements:** Must be in a Licking County 4-H club with a poultry project. Must live in Licking County and have a general knowledge of poultry.

**Royalty Obligations:** Promote poultry in Licking County by participating in the Hartford Fair royalty program and attending other local promotions. During fair week, royalty will be required to spend time at the Hartford fair in the poultry building helping with programs and giving out awards. In the event that the Senior or Junior King/Queen is unable to attend a function, the Senior or Junior first runner-up may be asked to take the place of the Senior or Junior King/Queen. In the event that the Senior or Junior King/Queen fails to fulfill the obligations of the position, at the discretion of the Licking County Poultry Committee, the first runner-up of either the Senior or Junior King/Queen may be asked to finish out the remaining term. After a contestant has been chosen Senior Royalty, that contestant is not eligible to compete again for Poultry Royalty. This gives more kids a chance to compete. After a contestant has been chosen as Junior royalty, this contestant must skip a year before competing for Senior Royalty. A contestant may only hold the position of Junior Royalty once.
