

**Licking County Cattlemen's Association
College Scholarship**

Guidelines and Application

The Licking County Cattlemen's Association College Scholarship is awarded by the Licking County Cattlemen's Association (LCCA). An applicant for the scholarship must adhere to the following guidelines:

1. The applicant must be a high school senior and attend a school in Licking County. The applicant or their parents must have been dues-paying members for at least one year and have paid the current year by the time this application is submitted.
2. Applicant must be preparing to enroll in their first year of education beyond high school.

Select the education plan from the list below that best describes your current plans for pursuing your education.

A.) Plan to pursue a two-year, junior college or vocational/technical school degree or certificate.

B.) Plan to attend a 4-year college/university or a 2-year college and transfer to a 4-year college to complete my degree.

3. Applicant must complete the following application. The application must be typed or written legibly in ink to be accepted. Applicant must attach a grade transcript to the application. All information will be held in the strictest confidence.
4. Applicant must have completed and exhibited a market beef and/or breeding beef project for at least two years at the Hartford Fair. This includes steer pool and dairy feeder projects. The beef projects must have been completed either through 4-H and/or FFA.
5. Application must be returned to: LCCA, c/o OSU Extension Licking County, 771 E. Main Street, Suite 103, Newark, OH 43055 no later than March 1st 2025.
6. Selection is based on extracurricular activities, and academic achievement without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, sex, or condition of disability. All applications will be screened by the LCCA Scholarship Committee. The decision of the Committee is final, and a decision may be made not to award a scholarship. A scholarship certificate will be presented to the recipient at the LCCA annual banquet. Check will be given after the Licking County Cattlemen's Association Scholarship Committee has received verification of college acceptance.
