

THE LICKING COUNTY PEST MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION

The Licking County Pest Management Committee is providing a scholarship opportunity. Applicants for the scholarship must meet the following guidelines:

ELIGIBILITY

- Sophomore or above in trade school or college (including Graduate Level) and enrolled for the next term.
- GPA Level: 3.0 or above
- Passionate intent to have a career path related to agriculture
- Past or present involvement with 4-H and/or FFA (or equivalent)
- Resident of Licking County
- Recipients are eligible to re-apply in following years

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

- Intent is to issue two scholarships of \$500 per school year based on qualified applicants

SELECTION AND AWARD

- Selection is based on financial need, extracurricular activities and academic achievement. All applications will be screened by the Scholarship Committee. The decision of the Committee is final. Scholarship award will be paid directly to recipient upon confirmation of enrollment and grades. Recipient must submit an active course schedule and grade/GPA verification before funds will be released.
