 Selection is based on financial need, extracurricular activities and academic achievement. All applications will be screened by the Scholarship Committee. The decision of the Committee is final. Scholarship award will be paid directly to recipient upon confirmation of enrollment and grades. Recipient must submit an active course schedule and grade/GPA verification before funds will be released.
